They carry some salt with them. Some of the sea water evaporates and moves into the air and clouds. Salt does not evaporate. It stays in the sea. The water in the seas has more salt than river water. Some seas have more salt than others.



Some lakes do not have rivers so the salt stays in the lake but some of the water evaporates. These lakes are very salty. The Dead Sea between Israel, West Bank and Jordan, Great Salt Lake in the USA and Tuz Gölü (Salt Lake) in Turkey are famous examples of this kind of lakes. These lakes are much saltier than the seas.
